

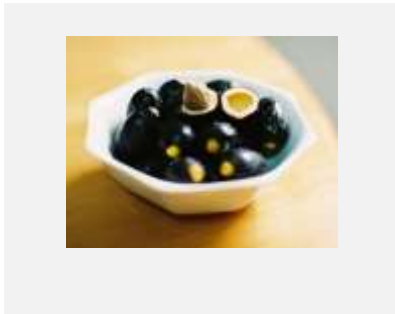

### Main characteristics/features

Sarawak dabai is regarded as an organic and healthy fruit. It is full of nutrients and high in antioxidants that are good for health. A good quality Sarawak dabai is characterised by being large in size, weighing about 18 g per fruit, having a thick and yellow-coloured aril, having a good nutty aroma and flavour and having a smooth texture.

### Geographical area

The geographical area is located in the state of Sarawak, along riverbanks in Sibu, Kapit and Limbang.

### Production and processing

The Sarawak dabai tree is a medium-sized tree growing to about 20 m. It has a tall straight trunk and large branches that only spread out at the top of the tree. It is also referred to as a 'sibu olive' or 'tropical olive'. The unripe fruit is white and later turns slightly reddish, eventually becoming dark purple when ripe. Sarawak dabai is oval or ellipsoid in shape and it is harvested approximately 120 days after flowering. The harvested fruit should be 3-4 cm long and 1.5-2 cm wide.

### Link between product and territory

Dabai (*Canarium odontophyllum* Miq.) is a popular indigenous fruit that grows naturally in Sarawak. It is commonly found along riverbanks in Sibu, Kapit and Limbang.
