Main characteristics/features

Geographical area

Isau or green longan (Dimocarpus longan var. malesianus) is from the family of sapindacacea. Isau is special compared to other types of longan because of its distinct colour and appearance.

The fruit is dark green and spherical, with numerous protuberances on the surface of its skin. As it ripens, the colour changes to a light yellowish-green and its protuberances flatten slightly to give it a smooth appearance.

The geographical area is located in the Sarawak region of Malaysia (Borneo).

Production and processing

Link between product and territory

Isau trees are medium-sized in height and have a perennial growing period. Unlike other types of longan, the Isau tree takes longer to bear fruit, anything from 8 to 10 years. Therefore, the Isau is considered as belonging to the group of fruits that have a long juvenile period.

The Isau tree grows naturally on the fertile alluvial soils of the upper river in the Rejang basin. These natural conditions give the fruit their specificity.
