Main characteristics/features

Durian nyekak fruit is green when not mature, later ripening to a golden yellow colour. Its colour ranges from light yellow to deep orange. The quality is variable, and selected clones have a sweet taste with a soft fragrance, and a very fine, smooth texture.

Geographical area

Durian nyekak is produced in central and northern Sarawak, Malaysia.

Production and processing

The Durian is a small to medium-sized tree with a low branching habit that grows to a height of some 12-20 metres. The flowers are bright crimson and the fruit, covered in short blunt spines, is typically round or ovoid. Each fruit is small, weighing from 200 grams to slightly over 1000 grams.

Link between product and territory

Durian nyekak (*Durio Kutejensis* Becc) of Bombacaceae are mainly found growing wild in mixed dipterocarp forests in central and northern Sarawak. Durian nyekak fruit is also cultivated in this region.
