Main characteristics/features

The Nanglae Pineapple (Sab Pa Rod Nang Lae) is a honey pineapple grown in the Nanglae subdistrict of Chiang Rai province. It is small and round in shape with a thin skin. It has fine, low-fibre, honey-coloured flesh which is sweet and juicy.

Nanglae Pineapples are grown in the Nanglae subdistrict, Muang district, Chiang Rai province.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The Nanglae subdistrict is a good location for growing pineapples because of its highlands and cold weather. It also has a considerable amount of rain with streams to water the plantations. The pineapples are grown on the slopes of the foothills found almost everywhere in the area. As the slopes allow excess water to drain away easily, this prevents the pineapple tree roots from getting too damp and rotting.
