Main characteristics/features

Khung Bangkachao Num Dok Mai Mango (Ma Muang Nam Dok Mai Krung Bang Krachao) is the kiew Nuan or Nam Dok Mai Phra Pra Daeng varieties. When mature and ready for harvest, the skin becomes greenish yellow with a firm yellow pulp with a sweet scent and taste. It has a light coloured seed.

Geographical area

It is grown in the Bang Kachao area of Samut Prakarn province. The area very close to downtown Bangkok, just on the opposite site of the Chao Praya river and is protected by the government for its rich plantation area.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Khung Bang krachao is a large area surrounded by the Chao Praya river not very far from its delta. It has the unique characteristic of being influenced by three kinds of waters namely, seawater, freshwater and brackish water. The weather in the area is tropical and rainy. All of these factors give the mangoes grown in this area a remarkably special taste.
