The Nakhon Phanom lychee (Lin Chee Nakhon Phanom) is of the Nor. Phor. 1 variety. It is large, oval and has a reddish-pink skin. It has a cloudy white flesh with a sweet, slightly sour taste.

Nakhon Phanom lychees are grown in Nakhon Phanom province.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Plantation areas in Nakhon Phanom province are located in the plain areas on the banks of the Mae Khong river. The soil in the area consists of loam mixed with gravel. The area normally receives a considerable amount of rain in the rainy season and it is cold in winter. The unique taste of the lychees grown in the area is attributable to all of these factors.
