#### Main characteristics/features

Nakhon Nayok Giant Marian Plum (Ma Yong Chid Nakhon Nayok) is available in the Toon Klao, Bangkhun Nont, Tha Dan, Chid Salika, Toon Thawai and Chid Sa-nga varieties. It has a unique orange-yellow colour. The fruit is normally large and oval in shape, with thick, crisp flesh, a pleasant fragrance and a sweet, tart taste.

#### Link between product and territory

The soil in Nakhon Nayok province is sediment built up by the water running down the hills. The combination of sandy clay and pebbles absorbs the water well. The soil in this area is also porous allowing air and water to pass through easily. The weather in the area is a mixture of hot and cold temperatures. These factors contribute to the unique characteristics and quality of the Nakhon Nayok Giant Marian Plum.
