Nakhon Nayok Sweet Marian Plum (Maprangwhan Nakhon Nayok) has specific characteristics including its golden colour, large size and oval shape, with a thin peel. The fruit is sweet and crisp with a pleasant fragrance and small seeds.

Nakhon Nayok Sweet Marian Plum is a Geographical Indication of the Don Lakhon subdistrict of Nakhon Nayok province, to the east of Bangkok.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The Don Lakhon subdistrict of Nakhon Nayok has been a well-known plantation area for the Sweet Marian Plum for a long time. The local farmers have developed their own varieties of the fruit. Soil in the area is sandy loam built up by regular flooding. The weather is a mixture of hot and cold temperatures. These geographical factors make the area suitable for growing these fruits and give them their distinct characteristics and taste.
