Main characteristics/features

Yarang Puko Pomelo has round shape with a calyx, sweet taste, good scent, thin skin, soft ruby colour pulp with tiny hairs like velvet. Puko in the Malayu language means 'emblem'. Yarang Puko Pomelo originated from the Thongdi Nakhonchaisri variety and was developed into a new and unique variety by local people in the area.

Yarang Puko Pomelo is grown in Yarang district of Pattani province.

The Pattani river, which runs through Yarang district, is the source of a naturally fertilised soil that is ideal for pomelo cultivation producing a fruit that is clearly distinctive from the same fruit produced in other areas.
