Tan Yong Mat Southern Langsat (Long Gong Tan Yong Mat) is local longkong to Narathiwat province. When young, the fruits are green and become yellow once they are mature. The peel of the fruit has no sap and can be peeled very easily. The pulp is segmented and is clear and sweet in taste.

Narathiwat province is located on a mountain range and consists of deep tropical forest in the far south of Thailand. The moist breeze from the sea ensures the area is always rainy and humid throughout the year. The soil in the area is a sandy loam which contains high levels of humus. All of these characteristics contribute to the uniqueness of longkong grown in the area.
