Prachin Durians are in Kan Yao, Mon Thong, Cha Nee, Kradum Thong or any other local varieties. Durians grown in the area normally have thick, dry and low-fibre pulp that has a rich, sweet taste.

Geographical area

The plantation areas of Prachin Buri province in the upper eastern part of Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The northern part of Prachin Buri province comprises mountain ranges, plateaux and a large virgin forest area, while the southern part comprises a riverbank and delta. The soil in the area has a good drainage capacity. The weather is very warm in summer with a lower temperature in winter. These factors contribute to making it a good area for growing fruit, especially durians.
