Main characteristics/features

Thepsadej Coffee (Kafae Thep Sadej) has an authentic aroma and smooth taste resulting from the way it is cultivated, relying heavily on the rich biodiversity in the area. Thepsadej Coffee is an Arabica strain that has a well-balanced, smooth taste and an authentic aroma.

Geographical area

Thepsadej subdistrict, Chiang Mai province, a well-known province in the north of Thailand. The coffee plantation is located in the Doi Saket area which has a beautiful mountain range with an altitude of 1 000-1 600 metres above sea level.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Thepsadej Coffee is planted together with other trees in the forest and in tea gardens where the soil is naturally fertilised and there is a rich biodiversity. During the coffee blossom season, bees and other insects will transport and mix the pollen from the coffee flowers and other flowers - including wild flowers - in the area, giving the coffee its authentic aroma and smooth taste.
