Main characteristics/features

Khuan Lang aromatic pomelos (Som O Hom Khuan Lang) are round and have no calyx. The pulp is a dark-pink or red colour and is soft and juicy with lean or even no seeds. They have a sour-sweet taste with no bitterness and the peel has a distinctive aroma.

Most of the area in Khuan Lang is river basin. The soil is fertile and slightly acidic with some underground water, which allows the pomelo trees to absorb a sufficient amount of water and grow effectively.
