Main characteristics/features

The Lamphun Biao Khiao Longan (Lam Yai Biao Khiao Lamphun) is a Biao Khiao Pa-Sao variety of longan. It is usually round in shape and brownish green in colour with a rough skin and cloudy white flesh. The flesh is usually firm and dry with a sweet taste. The seeds are oval in shape and glossy black.

Geographical area

Lamphun Biao Khiao Longans are grown in six subdistricts of the Mueang Lamphun district, Lamphun province, namely Nong Chang Khuen, Umong, Mueang Nga, Ton Thong, Rim Ping and Pratu Pa.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Many types of longan have been grown in Lamphun province for over 100 years. The Lamphun Biao Khiao Longan is grown in a small area near river banks in the valleys. Lamphun province normally has a stable, warm temperature with a slightly cooler breeze in winter, which is good for growing longans.
