Main characteristics/features

The Trat Golden Pineapple (Sab Pa Rod Trat Si Thong) is a Queen variety pineapple that is large, cylindrical in shape, with a thin skin and yellowy green in colour. The flesh has a golden colour and is dry with less fibre than other pineapples.

Geographical area

Trat Golden Pineapples are grown in Trat province in the southeast of Thailand.

Trat province plantations are located in Thailand's tropical climate area, on plains or hillsides sloping towards the Gulf of Thailand. The soil in the area has good drainage. Due to the high rainfall each year, the pineapples grown in Trat are larger than those grown elsewhere.
