Main characteristics/features

The Ratchaburi Aromatic Coconut (Ma Praw Nam Hom Ratchaburi) is a variety of dwarf coconut palm tree locally called Moo Si Khiao. The base of the coconut is round and it has a double layer of flesh. The coconut water is sweet and has a pandan-like fragrance.

Geographical area

This coconut is grown in seven districts of Ratchaburi province, namely Damnoen Saduak, Wat Phleng, Ban Pong, Mueang Ratchaburi, Bang Phae, Pak Tho and Photharam.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The plantation area comprises plains and lowland plains. Soil in this area is naturally fertilised loam and muddy loam. Annual rainfall is 1 500-2 000 mm. and the average temperature is 35°C. These factors make Ratchaburi Aromatic Coconuts sweet and fragrant.
