Main characteristics/features

Suphan Water Chestnut (Haew Supan) is the Chinese water chestnut variety. It has an onion-like shape with sweet, nutty, firm and crispy white flesh.

Geographical area

The plantation area for the Suphan Water Chestnut covers all of Suphan Buri Province located in the central part of Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

Soil in the Muang and Si Prachan districts of Suphan Buri province is fertile. The top layer of the soil normally has clay and mud while the lower part is clay or sandy clay which retains water well. It also has high level of potassium and other fertilisers needed by most kinds of trees and farming. The area also has a river which brings a natural water supply to the plantations in the area. This part of Thailand is recognised as one of the best for agriculture.
