Main characteristics/features

Ubon Ratchathani Hom Mali Rice (Khao Hom Mali Ubon Ratchathani) is paddy rice, brown rice and white rice of the Hom Mali 105 and Gor Kor 15 varieties grown in Ubon Ratchathani province during the wet season. The rice grains are slim and long. The white rice is glossy, fragrant and bright white in colour, and soft and sticky when cooked.

Geographical area

Ubon Ratchathani province which is located at the north-eastern border of Thailand by the Mae Khong River.

Production/processing

Ubon Ratchathani province comprises plateaux and high ground with plenty of forests and water sources. The soil in the area is sandy loam. The weather is cold and dry in winter with a high level of rainfall in the rainy season. These special characteristics of the area contribute greatly to the unique quality of the rice grown in the province.
