Main characteristics/features

The Kamphaeng Phet Banana (Kluay Kai Kamphaeng Phet) is a local banana variety with a sweet taste and firm flesh. It is creamy orange in colour and has a thin skin. When ripe, its skin becomes smooth and turns bright yellow with small black dots. The banana is medium to small in size.

Geographical area

Kamphaeng Phet Banana is grown in the area of Kamphaeng Phet province in the lower northern part of Thailand.

The soil in the Kamphaeng Phet province is naturally fertilised making it suitable for growing bananas. It is part of the Group of Soil Series No 33, known as the Kamphaeng Phet Soil Series, which contains mica and lime. The combination of the area's climate with the selection of a good variety and meticulous harvesting methods has resulted in Kamphaeng Phet Bananas' distinct taste and characteristics.
