Main characteristics/features

Uttaradit Long Lab Lae Durian is a Long Lab Lae variety with a round or oval shape. It is normally small, with a thin peel, thick dark yellow pulp and a soft fragrance. The flesh is creamy and sweet in taste and it has a light-coloured seed.

Geographical area

Uttaradit Long Lab Lae Durian is grown in Laplae, Muang and the Tha Pla district of Uttaradit province.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The soil in Uttaradit province is sandy that is called 'Din Daeng Pha Phu'. In the rainy season, rainwater runs off the mountain to the plain and agriculture area bringing with it nutrients which fertilise the durian trees.

The weather in the area is cold and dry in winter and humid with high level of rainfall in the rainy season.
