**Main characteristics/features**

Uttaradit Lin Lab Lae Durian is a durian of the Lin Lab-Lae variety with cylindrical shape, thin peel, fine and dry dark yellow pulp and light-colour seeds. It has creamy sweet taste, and its pulp is thick with less fiber. The fruit can be kept for a long time before it rots.

**Geographical area**

Uttaradit Lin Lab Lae Durians are grown in Lap Lae, Muang and ThaPla districts of Uttaradit province.

**Production/processing**

**Link between product and territory**

The soil in Uttaradit province is sandy and called 'Din Daeng Pha Phu'. In the rainy season, mountain rainwater runs down to the plain and agriculture areas bringing with it nutrients needed by durian trees.

The weather in the area is cold and dry in winter and humid with heavy rain in the rainy season.
