Main characteristics/features

Sukhothai pottery (Sangkhalok Sukhothai) is a glazed or unglazed type of clay pottery produced in Sukhothai province. The glazed pottery normally has visible crack patterns in its texture and is produced in white, brown or green. It can also be painted with artistic patterns.

Geographical area

Muang district and Si Satchanalai district, Sukhothai province.

Production/processing

Sukhothai pottery is made according to local knowledge passed down from generation to generation in the Muang and Si Satchanalai districts of Sukhothai province.

Link between product and territory

The clay in the Muang and Si Satchanalai districts of Sukhothai province is of an excellent quality. It contains iron and has a sticky texture, which is ideal for making pottery. When mixed with water it becomes soft and it is perfect for creating the potters' chosen forms. Thanks to the local knowledge passed down over the years, the pottery made in the area is renowned for its fine quality and distinctiveness.
