**Main characteristics/features**

Phitsanulok Bang Krathum Dried Banana (Kluay Tak Bang Krathum Phitsanulok) is seedless, sun-dried banana with a fine, dry flesh that is soft and sticky. It is produced from Mali-Ong, Nuan Chan, Pak Chong 50 or other local banana varieties.

**Geographical area**

Phitsanulok province and the Tha Lor subdistrict of Pichit province, in the upper-central part of Thailand.

**Production/processing**

**Link between product and territory**

Plantations in these areas are abundant in natural fertiliser and are exposed to direct sunlight. Due to the effect of the sea breeze, from either the Indian Ocean or Pacific Ocean depending on the time of year, the area has warm weather, suitable for growing bananas and for drying them in the sun.
