Main characteristics/features

Ta Lung Santol (Kra Thon Ta-Lung) is a santol with a round middle and a flat top and bottom. The peel is thin and tight with a velvet-like texture. Its pulp is quite dry and soft with a sweet taste and it is not astringent.

Geographical area

The plantation area is in Ta-Lung, Ngiu Rai and Pho Kao Ton sub-district of Lop Buri province.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The Ta Lung Santol cultivation area is a plateau with the Lop Buririver running through it. The river brings with it nutrients and sediments that fertilise the land (named "Nam Lai Sai Moon"), producing a sandy loam which is appropriate for growing santols. The tropical weather and the influence of a north-eastern breeze results in a distinctive santol.
