Main characteristics/features

The Nasan Rongrien rambutan (Ngoh Rongrien Nasan) is of the Rongrien variety, which is round, has a thin peel and a thick, dry flesh. The seed is easily removed. The fruit has a sweet taste and pleasant aroma.

Geographical area

Nasan Rongrien rambutans are grown in the districts of Ban Na San, Ban Na Doem and Wiang Sa in Surat Thani province, located in the southern part of Thailand.

Production/processing

Link between product and territory

The plantation area covers the foothill plains, through which the Tapi river runs. Soil in the area is naturally fertilised by the river and has a good water draining capacity with high levels of gypsum and magnesium. These factors, together with the long rainy season, make the area the best place to grow these unique quality rambutans.
