Main characteristics/features

Phangnga Salika Durian is a local durian variety from Phangnga province. It is round in shape and has a thin skin with short thorns. The pulp is thick, dark yellow and quite sweet. This variety of durians does not have a very strong fragrance. The core of the fruit is a rusty-red colour with lightcoloured seeds.

Geographical area

The Phangnga Salika Durian plantation areas cover all Phangnga province, which is a small province on the west coast of the southern part of Thailand.

Phangnga province has a long mountain range from north to south. Soil in the area is loam, muddy or sandy with a high level of acidity. The province has a high level of rainfall throughout the year.
