**Main characteristics/features**

Wang Nam Khiao Coffee (Kafee Wang Nam Khiao) refers to the Catimor F-7 Arabica and Chumphon 2 Robusta coffees grown at an altitude of 400-600 metres above sea level in the Wang Nam Khiao district of Nakhon Ratchasima province. Using a standardised method, the coffee cherries are processed into green beans, coffee powder and roasted coffee. The coffee has an authentic aroma and a taste that is widely accepted by consumers.

**Geographical area**

Wang Nam Khiao district of Nakhon Ratchasima province, located approximately 200 km to the north-east of Bangkok, Thailand.

**Link between product and territory**

The Wang Nam Khiao district of Nakhon Ratchasima province has a combination of mountains and hills with an average altitude of 300-700 metres above sea level. Therefore, the weather is cool throughout the year. This makes the area suitable for growing coffee in the shade of taller trees.
