Main characteristics/features

The Nonthaburi Yai Klam mango (Ma Muang Yai Klam Nonthaburi) is of the local Yai Klam variety. The fruit is heartshaped and slightly flat with thick flesh and very few strands. The seed is the same shape as the fruit itself. When ripe, the peel turns yellow and the thick flesh inside is a yellow-orange colour with an exquisite texture.

The Nonthaburi Yai Klam mango plantation area is in Nonthaburi province, just north of Bangkok.

The Chao Phraya river runs through Nonthaburi province. It is thanks to this river that there is such rich alluvial soil in the area, which is perfect for growing fruit.
