**Main characteristics/features**

The Satun Champedak (Champada Satun) is a champedak (*Artocarpus integer*) that is cylindrical in shape and with a thin peel. The aril is orangey yellow in colour (similar to the colour of the champak flower). The flesh is usually thick and golden or creamy yellow in colour. The pulp is also sweet and fragrant.

**Geographical area**

Satun Champedak is grown in Satun province.

Satun province is situated in the mountainous area on the tropical south western coast of Thailand where there are streams and rainfall is high throughout the year. The area is rich in underground water and the soil is naturally fertilised, with loam on top.
